Village Missions

Oriskany, VA



Oriskany is located in southwest Virginia at the base of the Shenandoah Valley surrounded by the Jefferson National Forest. This is an old mining town whose mines closed almost a century ago. Where there used to be almost 2,000 people with a railroad line, 3 churches, 5 stores and 3 gas stations there is now one church and one post office. All the others closed, burned, or were abandoned. We have a few farmers in the area with a number of retired folks. Others drive south over the mountains to work in Roanoke or north to a paper mill in Covington. We tell people that Oriskany is a small place where God is doing big things. It may be off the beaten path, but it is a path worth taking.

- In our 28 years here we have been encouraged to see God change lives. David teaches the Bible in four public elementary schools of our county and serves as chaplain and first responder for the fire and rescue squads. Ninette is involved with a community playhouse and the public schools. Pray that our interaction with those of our community will lead to their trust in the Lord.
- Pray we will be faithful in our many tasks.
- Pray for the young children David teaches in the schools that they will respond to the Lord in faith.
