Gold River, BC



Gold River, British Columbia, is a village of about 1,200 people tucked away in rainforest mountains on the west coast of Vancouver Island, which by the way is the longest island in North America. Surrounded by mountains, lakes, and rivers, the area abounds in wildlife and is incredibly beautiful. Once a thriving lumber and pulp/paper mill town, it shrank dramatically when the mills closed, and now is largely a retirement-age community, which is reflected in the church as well.
