Camp Creek is a beautiful valley located east of the Eugene-Springfield area of Oregon along the scenic McKenzie River. It is an area that sees the production of timber, hay, cattle, and an ever-increasing number of filberts. While there is farming in the area, most of the residents work in the nearby cities. Our area is one that experienced evacuations during the Holiday Farm Fire in September, but was spared from the damage that took place further up the McKenzie Valley. Camp Creek Church has received leadership from Village Missions since the 1950's and we have served here for over 20 years.
